Dispute Resolution: Arbitration

Comment: This Munich litigation practice is a sought-after name, especially in tax-related disputes. Several partners are also tax advisors or accountants, and the firm has one of the most highly renowned tax criminal lawyers in its ranks in Dr. Rainer Spatscheck. The firm is heavily involved in dealing with the civil law fallout of the dividend-stripping scandal. The lawyers have an in-depth understanding of complex tax and accounting law problems and, unlike many competitors, are not hampered by too many conflicts of interest. Because of current developments, the firm was able to deploy its energy law expertise in price adjustment disputes. Kuhli-Spatscheck is establishing herself alongside Kröck as an arbitrator for high-volume cases, especially in post-M&A proceedings with accounting law elements.

Company Succession and Trusts

Comment: The company succession practice of this MDP, where tax law predominated for a long time, has branched out significantly in the past three years. Clients are increasingly entrusting Kantenwein with traditional inheritance law structuring work and, in particular, inheritance disputes, even across national borders. In addition, the firm has begun to tackle the field of non-profit investment. Tax advice, tax law and ▶tax criminal law are accounting for more and more work, as taxation matters in cross-border relocation and the related issues, such as foreign currency profits, are becoming increasingly relevant in general. This is stretching the still small team to its limits. **Recommended:** Dr. Thomas Kantenwein, Dr. An-

Tax Criminal Law

Comment: This Munich firm now enjoys a place among the market leaders, thanks largely to extremely well-regarded partner Spatscheck, who is at the centre of the criminal law practice and also handles tax disputes. Litigation for the former chair of the Wirecard supervisory board and for a gold trading company concerning tax and customs offences is public knowledge. The latter is also an example of the rise in customs offences activity. "Cum-cum" and dividend-stripping cases are a part of the KZSP practice, as are insolvency offences. It therefore comes as no surprise that Spatscheck's door is increasingly being knocked on by PE firms, tax advisors, accountants and lawyers, who have recently become the targets of the Munich tax authorities.

Munich Analysis



München

Comment: With its combined tax and dispute resolution specialty, this MDP plays a unique role among the well-connected, broadly positioned, midsized Munich firms. A look at the firm's growth shows just how successful this strategy is: the number of fee earners has nearly doubled since the mid-2010s; there are eight lawyers in tax criminal law alone. The partners are also involved in numerous complex, sometimes very high-profile proceedings, for instance regarding dividend-stripping deals. In Kuhli-Spatscheck, the firm has a well-regarded arbitrator in its ranks. The firm also enjoys frequent work in extensive proceedings in the banking and insurance sectors. Competitors who focus solely on the litigation side of Kantenwein's activity sometimes overlook how active the firm is in providing ongoing advice, both for companies and high-net-worth families and individuals, often with a focus on trust law issues.
